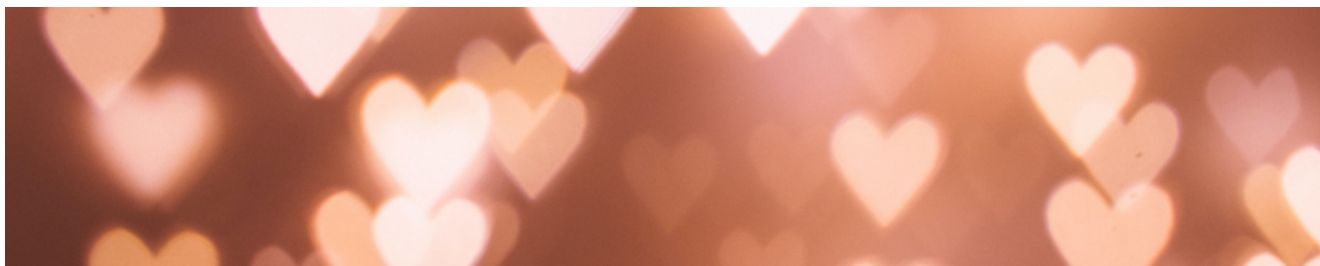


A Look at the the Top Movie Love Story Moments
